The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Panola County Emergency Services District #1 from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Panola County Emergency Services District #1 may adopt without holding an election to seek-voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Panola County Emergency Services District #1 is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 2, 2025 AT 12:00 PM AT CARTHAGE CIVIC CENTER, 1702 S. ADAMS ST., CARTHAGE, TX 75633.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Panola County Emergency Services District #1 is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Panola County Emergency Services District #1 at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
